At the last status call you denied the Government's motion for a continuance without prejudice to renewal but withdraw the Court's pretrial order. The Court also, that afternoon ~~February 21, 1979~~ (March 9, 1979) permitted the plaintiff to depose Mr. Brinson and ordered the plaintiff to write a brief and file it with the Court by Monday March 12, 1979 at 4:00 p.m. The brief was filed a day late. Trial is scheduled for ~~Monday March 12~~, 1979.
