III. THE LAST STATUS CALL

At the last status call on October 21st, which was very brief since you were in the midst of the Grant v. C&P trial, you again ordered Synanon to produce any information which had been hidden and any inventories of evidence that had been destroyed. You also said you would not order the production of information relied on by Bette Fleishman, beyond what you had already authorized, especially not grand jury material. This seems to resolve, orally, plaintiff's pending motion to require the government to produce (ripe 9/1).

IV. SINCE THE LAST STATUS CALL

- A. Plaintiff responded to the court's order to produce with a memo on Oct. 25th, saying it had nothing more to turn over.
- B. Chief Judge Robinson denied Synanon's request for information regarding the government's grants of immunity on Nov. 9th.
- C. Mr. Wadden withdrew from further representation of Synanon and informed the court by letter of Nov. 10th.
