NAACP v. Clarendon Hardware, 102 SCt 3407 ('82)

@ 3427: 1st A. doesn't protect violence

mere assoc. is insuff. predicate for L - @ 3432.

But Q is indiv's L for grp. boycott (damaged), & L of org.

"The NAACP - like any other org. - of course may be held ~~to~~ responsible for the acts of its agents throughout the country that are undertaken w/in the scope of their actual or apparent authority."

CF. Amer. Soc. of Mech. Engin., 102 SCt 1135].

Moreover, the NAACP may be found L for other conduct of which it had knowledge + specifically ratified". @ 3435

In 21 Q: Reg. 1.501(c)(3)-~~§~~ 1(c)(1). An org. will ~~not~~ be regarded as "operated exclusively" for exempt purposes if more than an insubstantial part of its activities is ~~not~~ in furtherance of an exempt purpose. Thus, an org., whatever its ~~not~~ public benefit, can be denied tax-exempt status if certain of its activities violate a law or public policy, when the activities (1) betray a non-exempt purpose, + (2) are a pervasive, recurring, + systematic part of its activities. [IRS brief @ 61]

Tank Truck - can't deduct fines even for innocent violations
