
Upon Joint Notice of Dismissal filed by Appellant and Appellee, the Commission hereby **DISMISSES** appeal no. 701, with prejudice.



JOINT NOTICE OF DISMISSAL


Now come the parties which submit the Joint Notice of Dismissal for the subject appeal.
