
MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT


On July 15, 1986, Chief's Order No. 86-258 was issued to Richard W. Barthel, finding that the Barthel No. 1 well, Permit No. 4407, Richard Barthel Lease, Bedford Township, Coshocton County, was incapable of producing oil or gas in commercial quantities and ordering that this well be properly plugged and abandoned. An appeal was filed by Richard Barthel from this order.

On or after December 4, 1986, Appellant Richard Barthel began utilizing the above-referenced well to produce gas for domestic purposes. Since this well is being used to produce gas for domestic purposes, this well is not required to be plugged and accordingly, the issues raised in Chief's Order No. 86-258 are moot.

THEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that this Board dismiss this appeal.
