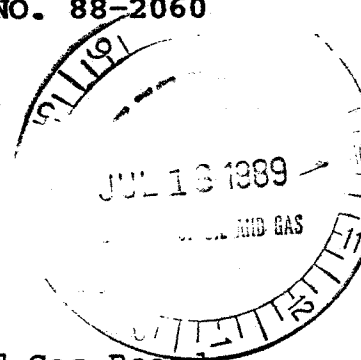

ENTRY

This matter came on for hearing before the Oil and Gas Board of Review on July 11, 1989, pursuant to Appeal No. 342, Chief's Order No. 88-2060, filed by John Rauch. Appellee's Motion to Dismiss the Appeal was denied by the Oil and Gas Board of Review on a vote of two members in favor, two members opposed.

Based on the testimony of witnesses, the uncontested evidence of the condition of the well subject to the Order, and the lack of any evidence to contradict the findings of the Chief, the Oil and Gas Board of Review found the Order of the Chief, No. 88-2060, to have been lawful and reasonable and the Board **ORDERS** that Appeal No. 342 is hereby **DISMISSED** and that Chief's Order No. 88-2060 be and hereby is **AFFIRMED**.
