

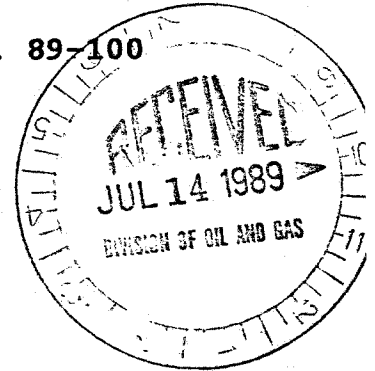


ENTRY FOR DISMISSAL


In a Request for Dismissal of Appeal, the appellant has moved the Ohio Oil and Gas Board of Review to dismiss Appeal No. 346.

Chief's Order No. 89-100

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The parties agree to the following stipulations:

1. Upon the filing of this settlement agreement with the Oil and Gas Board of Review, Appellant withdraws the above-referenced appeal.

2. Upon the filing of this settlement agreement, the Appellant shall demonstrate mechanical integrity for the James Price No. 1 well, Gallia County, Permit No. 694, on or before sixty (60) days of the Entry of this Order. If after the sixty (60) day period, Appellant fails to demonstrate mechanical integrity for the James Price No. 1 well, Gallia County, Permit No. 694, Appellant agrees to the following:

- (a) Cease using the well for annular disposal;
- (b) Remove all disposal apparatus, including the line from the saltwater holding tank to the wellhead; and,
- (c) Submit a plan for saltwater disposal for the wells using the James Price No. 1 well for annular disposal.

3. Appellant waives its right to any further appeal of
Order No. 89-100.
