

CONSENT DECISION

A. On November 12, 1991, Chief's Order No. 91-574 was issued to Akron/Oil Corp. (Appellant) ordering it, its successors, assignees, and agents to plug a well in Pleasant Township, Perry County, specifically, Permit No. 6235, Well No. 1, Jay Lucas lease. Chief's Order No. 91-574 further ordered that all work to properly plug and abandon the well be completed in a prudent and workmanlike manner within 30 days of receipt.

B. On or about December 13, 1991, Appellant filed an appeal of Chief's Order No. 91-574 with the Oil and Gas Board of Review.

C. Prior to hearing of any issue of law or fact in this appeal, an agreement was reached between the parties to this action which disposed of the need of hearing on this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, in settlement of this matter, the parties hereby agree to the following:

1) Appellant Akron Oil Corp., consents to the entry of this CONSENT DECISION and waves any objection or further right to appeal it may have with respect to this appeal for the purpose of settling the claims alleged in the appeal.

2) The provisions of this CONSENT DECISION shall apply to and be binding upon the parties to this action, their agents, officers, employees, assignees, heirs, and successors in interest.

3) Appellant agrees to place into production the oil and gas wells identified as Permit No. 6235, Well No. 1, on the Jay Lucas Lease, Pleasant Township, Perry County, Ohio on or before February 16, 1993.


4) If the above described well has not been placed into production by February 16, 1993, Appellant agrees to properly plug and abandoned said well on or before March 16, 1993.

5) Appellant shall complete all work on the wellsite in a prudent and workmanlike manner, and in compliance with the requirements of R.C. Chapter 1509 and the rules adopted thereto.

6) Nothing in this CONSENT DECISION shall be construed so as to prejudice the right of the Division of Oil and Gas to issue other decisions and orders to enforce the provisions of Revised Code Chapter 1509 and Chapter 1501 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

7) All parties to this action state that they have read this CONSENT DECISION, understand its terms, have the ability to comply with its terms, and agree to comply fully.

8) Appeal No. 490 is dismissed with prejudice.


