**CONSENT AGREEMENT**



## CONDITIONS

3 By September 30, 2000, Paul Grimm shall have placed the Munday No. 1 Well into production. If the Munday No. 1 Well is not placed into production by September 30, 2000, it shall be plugged in accordance with Ohio's oil and gas laws by September 30, 2000

4. If the Munday No. 1 Well is plugged as required by the terms of this Consent Agreement the well site shall be restored, as required by R.C. 1509 072(B), by October 30, 2000

5 If the Munday No. 1 Well is not in production or plugged by September 30, 2000 or its well site not restored by October 30, 2000, Paul Grimm shall pay the Division \$1,000. In addition, for each month after September 30, 2000 for which the well is not plugged and for each month after October 30, 2000 that the Munday No. 1 well site is not restored, Paul Grimm shall pay \$100 per month.

6. Paul Grimm shall be responsible to follow-up at the subject well site to insure full compliance with the requirements of R.C. Chapter 1509 and Ohio Admin. Code Chapter 1501., including but not limited to the establishment of vegetative cover to bind the soil and prevent substantial erosion. If necessary, Paul Grimm will reseed the site until proper growth occurs.


7 All work on the well or well site will be performed in a prudent and workmanlike manner and in compliance with the requirements of R.C. Chapter 1509 and Chapter 1501. of the Ohio Admin. Code.

8. Nothing in this **CONSENT AGREEMENT** shall be construed so as to prejudice the right of the Division of Oil and Gas to issue other decisions and orders to enforce the provisions of R.C. Chapter 1509 and Ohio Admin. Code Chapter 1501 including the seeking of civil penalties for the failure to comply with this Consent Agreement.


9 In the event of any default of the terms set forth herein, the Division may elect any and all remedies it deems appropriate. Further, in the event of default, Paul Grim, his heirs, assigns, and successors-in-interest agree that, in any litigation brought by the Division to enforce this Consent Agreement venue shall be proper in the Franklin County Ohio Court of Common Pleas.


10 Appeal 654 is dismissed with prejudice.

11 The Division of Oil and Gas reserves all rights to enforce R.C. Chapter 1509 and Ohio Admin. Code Chapter 1501. including but not limited to the right to file a civil enforcement action seeking injunctive relief and civil penalty for noncompliance with this Consent Agreement.
