BACKGROUND

This matter came before the Oil & Gas Commission upon appeal by Energex Oil & Gas Corporation from Chief's Order 2000-67. This Chief's Order required the plugging or production of a well in Vinton County, Ohio, known as the Huntley No. 1 Well.

On April 10, 2002, the Division informed the Commission that through investigation, the Division determined that the Huntley No. 1 Well is currently being operated for domestic purposes. Thus, Chief's Order 2000-67, requiring the plugging of the Huntley No. 1 Well, will be vacated by the Division. The Division requested that appeal #694 be **dismissed, as moot.**

ORDER

The Oil & Gas Commission has considered Appellee's request and finds it well taken. WHEREFORE, the Commission hereby **DISMISSES** appeal #694, with prejudice, as this matter has been rendered moot.
