Dear Ms. Kahn:

I am writing to advise you that the above referred to matter has been settled by my client, D & L Energy, Inc., and Jacqueline Reeves. As you know, Ms. Reeves is represented by Eric Johnson, Esquire. Today, Eric and I reached the following settlement in this matter:

1. Jacqueline Reeves will grant my client an oil and gas lease applicable to the approximate .03 acre tract, which is the tract of land necessary for the 500' radius from the well.
2. Jacqueline Reeves will waive her landowner's royalty interest as to said lease in return for a 3.25% overriding royalty interest in the entire unit, said overriding royalty interest to be effective for all production after January 1, 1993.
3. My client will pay Jacqueline Reeves the sum of \$7,000.00.


