


JOINT NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL


Now come the parties to the above action and hereby jointly notify the Oil and Gas Board of Review that the instant appeal, Appeal No. 466, has been jointly resolved as follows:

1. Appellant Petroleum Energy Production Corporation is in compliance with Chief's Order No. 91-238 in that all of the wells contained in Chief's Order No. 91-238 with the exception of Permit No. 2008, the Ebert #1 well located in Coshocton County, have been transferred to Green Gas Company who has sufficient surety to meet the requirements of Revised Code Chapter 1509;

2. Appellant Petroleum Energy Production Corporation is in compliance with Chief's Order No. 91-238 in that the Ebert #1 well, Permit No. 2008, located in Perry Township, Coshocton County, has been transferred to Kenoil who has proper surety pursuant to Revised Code Chapter 1509;
3. Therefore, without need for a hearing of this matter, the parties hereto jointly withdraw Appeal No. 466 with prejudice.
