The Journal solicits articles on pre-selected themes within the broad area of international and comparative law. Unsolicited articles within the pre-selected themes and student contributions on any international or comparative law topic will be welcomed. The article should be timely and provide more than just a summary of the current literature. Analysis should be thorough and original. Contributing authors are required to submit three copies of the manuscript. Unpublished manuscripts will not be returned to the author unless requested.

Articles should be concisely written, scholarly, and articulate. The introduction should contain a clear statement of the thesis. Descriptive material should be limited to the necessary background information. The body of the text should follow a logical progression to the conclusion. Use of direct quotations should be kept to a minimum.

All major points must be substantiated by reference to at least one authoritative source. Sources relied on should be recent and sufficient to indicate a thorough coverage of the topic. Over-dependence on a few sources should be avoided.

Authors should cite only to authorities which they have personally consulted. All citations should be contained in the footnotes. Footnotes may also elaborate on points raised in the text. Research sources which support points peripheral or contrary to those discussed in the text should be included and clearly noted.
